The BEST Program consists of
the following components:



BAY Mentor- Bay Mentor is Save The Bay's multi-age interdisciplinary environmental leadership and service-learning module. The program trains upper level high school students to be educators and mentors for younger students during community based field restoration programs. Through a peer mentoring dynamic, students instruct other students on various aspects of wetland restoration.

Community Action Project (CAP)- Inspired by their restoration experience, Bay mentors will submit a CAP project that demonstrates their readiness to move from awareness to action. The CAP provides students with the skills and experience to take action right in their own backyard or on their school campus.

Annual Environmental Summit- The Annual Environment Summit is conference that brings mentors together from around the Bay to showcase their leadership achievements and raise the profile of these emerging leaders.
