# Save The Bay's Restoration Education Programs

## BAY DISCOVERY

- One-time restoration education field trip that connects students to the San Francisco Bay estuary and engages them in critical tidal marsh restoration.
- Grades 5-12, 15-35 students per trip.

## SEED: Students Engaged in Ecological Design

- Three seasonal field trips and one classroom session over the course of the school year that involve students in the entire cycle of wetland restoration from seed collection to nursery work to planting.
- Grades 6-12, 15-35 students per trip.

## DIRT: Digging into Restoration Technology

- Two field trips and one classroom session that provide students a hands-on way to learn how to collect and analyze data on soil moisture, salinity and pH.
- Grades 9-12, 15-30 students per trip.

## BEST: Bay Environmental Stewardship Training

- One classroom and two field sessions designed to train students in planning and delivering a restoration science curriculum to younger learners.
- Mentor students: grades 11-12, Mentee students: grades 6-9, 15-20
